Boot camp is over and we are looking for a few good men and women to participate in advanced Army training, where students will learn how to lead a team, weapons training, survival training, leadership training and missions.



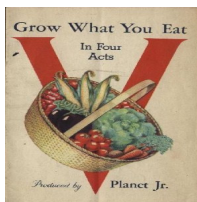
In the Army Now: Boot Camp for Girls: 3rd – 8th Grade
